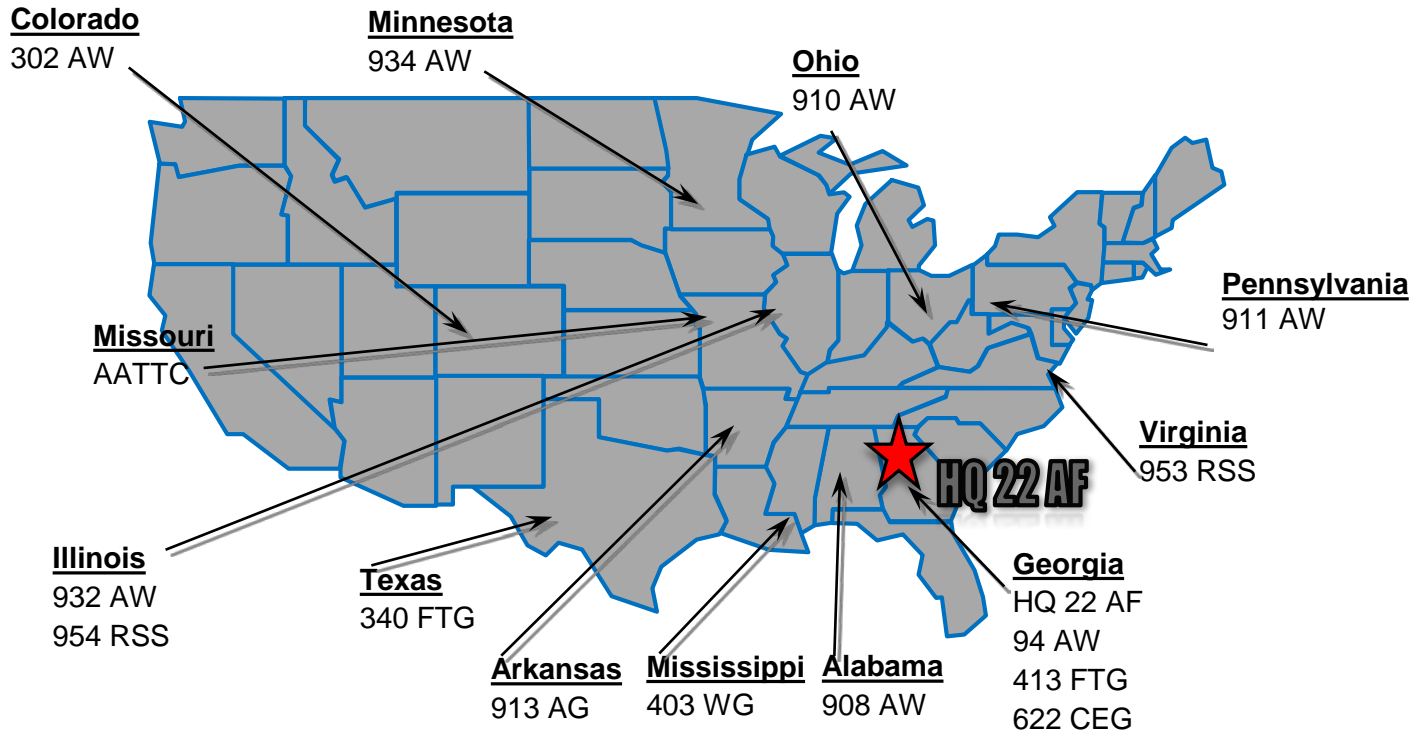

- Worldwide medical services to the warfighter – Frontline to CONUS fixed medical treatment facilities



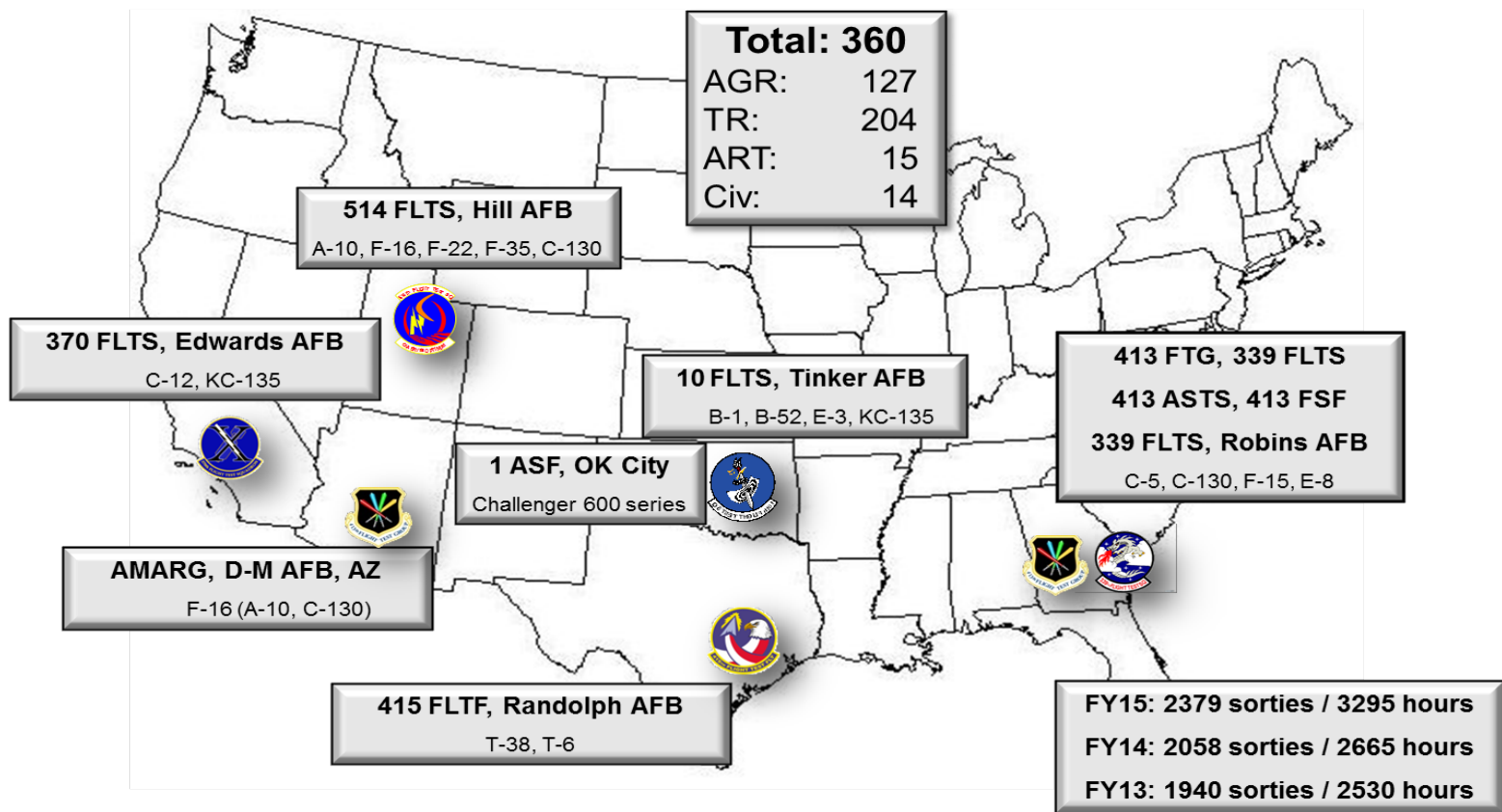

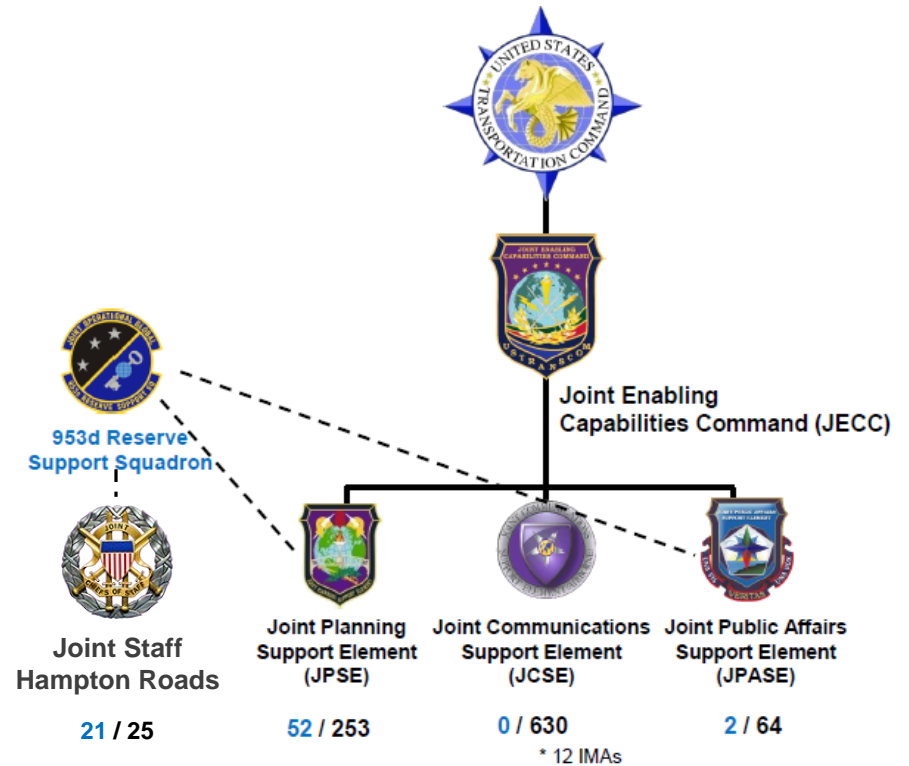


954 RSS – Scott AFB, IL

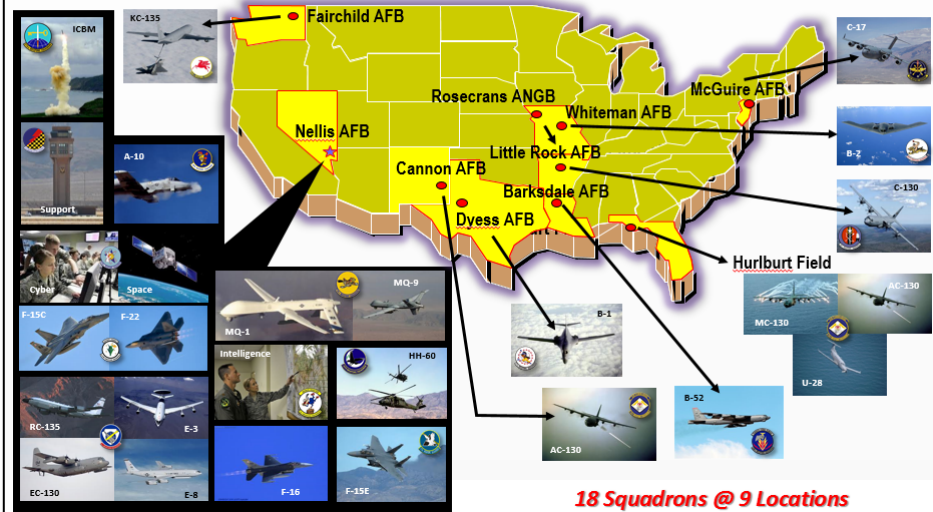

- WC-130Js are equipped with meteorological data-gathering instruments

AERIAL SPRAY

- Modified C-130H2 aircraft
- Mission supports Federal Emergency Management Agency
- Responds to public health emergencies and oil spills—
Katrina, Deep Water Horizon
- Sprays for mosquitoes, moths,
weed control on bombing ranges





302nd Airlift Wing

MAFFS II

- Modified C-130H3 aircraft at Peterson AFB, CO
- Modular Airborne Firefighting System
- Direct support to U.S. Forest Service
- Carries 3,000 gallons of retardant
- Discharge: 5 seconds/Reload: 12 minutes
- Fire containment does not extinguish, but contains fire
