

Tactical Airlift



- C-130H Hercules & C-130J Super Hercules
- Inter and intra-theater airlift
- Cargo and personnel airdrop







Aeromedical Evacuation



- Patient movement via mobility aircraft
- Inflight medical care
- Ground patient staging platforms
- 70% of Air Force AE capability resides in the Air Reserve Component
- 22 AF AE units comprise one-third of the AFRC capability

MAFFS II

- Modified C-130H3 aircraft at Peterson AFB, CO
- Modular Airborne Firefighting System
- Direct support to U.S. Forest Service
- Carries 3,000 gallons of retardant
- Discharge: 5 seconds / Reload: 12 minutes
- 25% of DoD MAFFS capability

HURRICANE HUNTERS

- 53rd Weather Reconnaissance Squadron at Keesler AFB, MS
- WC-130Js equipped with meteorological data-gathering instruments
- 100% of DoD Weather Reconnaissance capability









910th Airlift Wing





AERIAL SPRAY

- Modified C-130H2 aircraft
- Mission supports FEMA
- Responds to public health emergencies and oil spills— Hurricane Irma, Deep Water Horizon
- Sprays for mosquitoes, moths, weed control on bombing ranges
- 100% of DoD fixed-wing Aerial Spray capability






